#### City of Pelican Rapids Park Board Meeting

Additions/Deletions: Skating rink

Bike Path: Funding did not come through but still trying to work with State on path(Swan subdivision 108). Other option is to try again for Legacy Grant next year. It can be an expensive proposition however, to apply for grants that you do not receive. You have to start at square one.

Skating Rink: Zierke made a motion and Holmgren seconded the motion to recommend to City Council to move the location of existing rink to the location where it was before, below the elementary school. Usage was down this year and the feeling that it is do to location.

Pagoda: Gottenborg gave pictures to Karl Grefsrud who is estimating the price to be any where from \$5,000 to \$6,000. Request will be made to Oktoberfest for donation. Gottenborg talked to Arvig and a grant has been submitted Friday, February 22 and we should hare by the end of the month.

Velo land: Daryl does not call back, so Gottenborg will write a request to Velos to keep the land as a green space.

Pool: Meeting being held today, February 25<sup>th</sup> at 12:00p.m. Discussing old bath house and possibly converting it into a storm shelter. We need more information at the park/pool as to what Pelican Rapids has to offer to visitors, for example, restaurants, specialty shops, grocery stores, ect.
