Meeting called to order at 8:08 a.m.

Motion to approve August 31st 2011 meeting: Irej made that motion and Magnusson seconded.

Additions and deletions: West Central Initiative Fund regarding the pool
Sherin Park Campground

Council action since last meeting: None

Veterans Memorial Park: Path is good, monument base up and ready for flag poles. Need one more load of wood chips to be delivered. Benches set. There should be cement around monument for ease of maintenance-shrubs might be nice and pavers. Parkboard will go look at it and decide. Karl may go ahead and pour concrete(stamped). Grass will be taken care of next year(spring). Zierke will contact Aakre. Probably cost .25 cents/per sq.ft. to aroseed.

2012 budget issue: Black dirt and seeding in park and park signs that Glenis Metcalf will paint.

Drinking fountain will be a spring Rotary project.

W.C.I. funding for pool: People could donate to a community fund for that purpose and the West Central Initiative Fund would manage distribution of an endowment fund if 10,000 dollars is made by Dec. 31st. Motion made by Magnusson to start endowment for the swimming pool. Seconded by Gottenborg. Will bring idea to Council. Brian Olson is going to work on issues in Sherin Park this winter concerning reservations in campground, and also two areas that could be divided up into two to three areas to developed into campsites. Ideas were discussed to develop knowledge about our campsites. Are there possibilities to access additional land along river to make into a seasonal campground? Zoning concerns will be brought to council for Comprehensive Plan (revision plan).
