Meeting called to order at 8:11 a.m. by Irey as acting chair  
Motion was made and seconded to approve October 26<sup>th</sup> meeting

Additions/Deletions: Second wall (Marlys Johnson), park signs and grass seed: No deletions

Council actions since last meeting: None

Pool Committee: Solga wants to check with Hawley for a template to organize members, etc. for this committee.

Park Board members: Current park board members will talk to community individuals to find those who may be interested in joining the park board

Meeting time: Denise will talk to Dave about an afternoon time

5 year plan: Look it over and this item will be added to January agenda.

Second wall: Oktoberfest to pay for the second tier. The plaque is on the bench. The second wall is not in as this will be a spring project.

Signs: Still need to update Veterans Memorial Park sign and four signs for the parks. Glenace Metcalf has moved out of town, but may help with the wind mill sign.  
In discussing signs, wondering about having Indigo do the signs with vinyl for longer lasting and lower upkeep of signs. Olson will contact Dave Selvig for an estimate. Plexi glass signs worked well with Skate Park sign. Their might be a chance Oktoberfest would be interested in this project.

Grass seed: Irey will talk to Zierke and find out where grass seed and Aakre stand. There is \$4,200 left in Veterans Memorial Park fund and the Park Board feels that we could legitimately use it for other park expenses, as Veterans Memorial Park is finished.

City Comprehensive Plan: Some discussion on the Plan being revisited by the Planning Commission and they like the idea of the bike/walking path and seasonal campground. This will have to be a community wide project. Discussion in general on ideas concerning this issue.
