Council actions since last meeting: Did approve of moving forward with vinyl sign project and also campground improvements,(3-4 new sites added).

Veterans Memorial Park: Gottenborg reported that everything looks healthy. Olson is waiting for a quote on price to help with grass issues. A cost of possibly \$3,000 was mentioned. Discussion was held on the possibility of the Memorial Day Parade centering around this park.

David Brown Field: The old shed will be coming down.

Chairs: Magnusson will refer any painting or repair work expenses for chairs to be approved by Olson.

Drinking Fountain: Gottenborg and Olson will get together with Marty regarding hook up.

Barbecue Pits: There are repair issues again and Gottenborg will bring this up at Rotary's next meeting and report back to Park Board.
