Campground Rules & Information

Campground guidelines

Check out time is 12:00 pm (noon) on the last day registered. Your campsite must be cleaned prior to checking out.

Check in time is after 2 p.m. on the first day registered.

RV camping is allowed at designated sites only. One RV unit is permitted per RV site. \$20 per site.

Tent camping in Site #11 & grassy areas only. Two tents are permitted per tent site. \$15 per tent.

A maximum of 6 people & 2 pets can stay at each campsite. Fires are allowed in grills and fire rings only. Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. During non-quiet hours noise must be kept at a minimal level.

There is a 14-day maximum camping limit in any 30-day period.

No changing campsites or moving reservation cards.

No cutting or debarking trees, branches or shrubs on park property.

No disturbing wildlife or defacing park property.

No all-terrain vehicles (ATV's, Rangers, Dirt Bikes, etc) operating on park property.

No alcohol or controlled substances.

No cleaning fish, washing dishes or pets in park buildings.

No discharge of waste water onto park property or the river.

No smoking on park property, including park buildings.

No fireworks.

No loitering.

Minors (under 18 years of age) are not allowed to rent a campsite. Campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian

Sites must be paid for in advance either at City Hall or in the drop box. No refunds will be given.

Reservations are encouraged and can be made at City Hall by calling 218-863-7076. Drop in campers will be asked to change sites, if that site is reserved during their stay.

Tent sites are available for \$15 per tent. Electric only RV sites available for \$20 per site (Water fill & dump station available).

Pet guidelines

Pets must be on a leash no more than six feet long and cannot be tethered to any tree, plant, building or park property (picnic tables, benches, shelters, etc). Pets must be attended at all times. Pet owners must carry & use an appropriate device for cleaning up pet feces and disposing of feces in a sanitary manner. No excessive barking or noise. Limit of 2 pets per site, must be up to date on vaccinations and provide proof of vaccinations.

Park Grounds will be monitored by City/Park Staff and Pelican Rapids Police Department (218-863-1351) and we reserve the right to ask anyone to leave the park if any of the above rules are not being followed.
