# Hydrant Flushing NOTICE



Some may experience a momentary loss of water pressure during this time. If, after flushing, your water becomes rusty, run your tap for a few minutes and the water should clear up.

### FEATURED ORDINANCE : PUBLIC NUISNCE ORDINANCE

Let's make Pelican Rapids look great for the this summer!

Below are two examples of Pelican Rapids Municipal Code, Chapter 8 nuisances:

**Chapter 8, Section 801.03, Subd 7, of City Code states that "Accumulations in the open of discarded or disused machinery, household appliances, automobile bodies or other material" is classified as a public nuisance.**

**Chapter 8, Section 801.03, Subd 14, of City Code states that "The storage of any unlicensed, unregistered or inoperable vehicle or the storage of household furnishings or appliances on public or private property, unless housed within a lawfully erected building is hereby declared to be a nuisance".**

An auto salvage yard can assist you in moving any unauthorized vehicles. Unwanted debris and materials can be disposed of at the Pelican Rapids Transfer Station or by calling the local garbage service.

#### *A Reminder from the Street Department*

*Please DO NOT rake  
leaves or blow lawn clip-  
pings into the streets*



It is against City Ordinance 302.5 to deposit leaves, grass, sand or other materials on city streets or in the street gutters. By mowing the first two rounds back onto your property and not into the street, the grass won't wash into the storm drains and clog them.

**Subdivision 3. Limited Open Sales.** Residents are allowed on a limited basis to sell motor vehicles, boats, Recreation vehicles and equipment subject to the following limitations:

1. No more than a total of three items per site can be advertised for sale per calendar year.
2. No more than two items can be displayed for sale at any one time per property.
3. Individual items may not be displayed for sale in excess of thirty days in the aggregate for all items displayed.
4. Items sold are limited to articles owned by residents of the open sales site.
5. Sale items may not be placed on the public right of way.
6. One sign not exceeding two square feet in area advertising the sale item is allowed, such sign is to be placed within or attached to the sale item.

**Subdivision 4. Exception.** This Section shall not apply to any sale under court order, nor to any bona fide auction sale, nor to a sale of farm or garden products by the person producing same.
