

The City of Pelican Rapids held its meeting on October 27th, 2014 at City Hall Council Chambers, City Hall 315 N. Broadway.
The meeting was called to order at 8:08 a.m.

Board members present: Van Holmgren, Dave Gottenborg, and Denise Magnusson. Don Solga and Brian Olson were also present.

Approval of minutes: Gottenborg made the motion and Magnusson seconded the motion.

Additions/Deletions: Historic City Hall lighting

Snowmobile bridge is functional. In the spring we will see what finishing work around the bridge may be needed.

Velo Land is still a stagnant issue at this point in time.

The Pergola is fine except would still like to see some more boards at the top.

The Welcome Chairs have been stored for the season. There is no money in the chair budget at this time.

Brown field is being used. Park Board is still interested in putting in a shelter at the field.

Swimming Pool is done for the season.

Signage east of Old City Hall for public restrooms states hours of use are those that the Chamber is open.

New lighting considerations became astronomically expensive for Old City Hall. Wayne Runningan is working on this issue. May change lighting to a different style, probably LED. Track lighting would be too expensive to retrospect that to LED. Need to talk to an electrician to see what it would cost to set that up.

There may be some money in Veteran Park fund that could be used towards lighting project. The Chamber is looking into a sign for Old City Hall, similar to signage on Riverview Place. Olson will talk to Chamber and see where they are on that issue.

Some discussion was held on Bike trail. County has applied for grant monies, should know results in February. If approved won't be available until 2016. It would get us from Lake Region property to Highway #3. Solga hopes to work with Lake Region to asphalt trail by the pond.

Motion to adjourn was made by Gottenborg and seconded by Magnusson.
