Board held discussion on various projects in the parks. Included was discussion of a trail head, parks in general, extended lodging and maps for people visiting Pelican Rapids. Pool: Study is still being done as to cost of maintenance, i.e.(heating, etc.). We may be looking at renovation of the old pool instead of a new enclosed pool, due to cost. One million to renovate vs 7 million for new. This project may take a couple years to get started.

Veterans Park: Oktoberfest is talking of funding for new banners and coming up with a design.

Zierke made a motion to use leftover money from Veterans Memorial Park for a pagoda in the area. Gottenborg seconded the motion and all approved. Gottenborg will research material to use and the style of the structure. This WiFi hot spot would be sponsored by West Central Telephone.
