Meeting was called to order at 8:05 a.m.

Board members present: Len Zierke, Dave Gottenborg, Van Holmgren, and Denise Magnusson. Don Solga and Brian Olson were also present.

Approval of minutes: Gottenborg made the motion and Magnusson seconded the motion.

Additions/Deletions to agenda: Parks Summaries, and budget issues

Park Summaries: Olson said new camp sites are up and all electric sites booked. Park Board needs to give any budget requests by the next meeting(June 30th), to Solga.

Velo land: Olson has been mowing the property throughout the season.

Pergola: this will become a fall project along with issues at the Brown Soccer Field.

Signage: could we have signage up for Public Bathrooms by "Art in the Park" event? Paula Waller is the head of this, check with her concerning this idea, also, Holmgren will talk to Eric Guler(Chamber president).

Bike Trail: Need to determine a name for the path. The County Commissioners are still moving forward on this. Was not funded in this legislative session but Legislators are on board with this project. Will try again.

Zierke saw to it that some more chairs were purchased and placed on Main Street for the Pelican Rapids' events.

Motion was made by Holmgren to adjourn at 9:08a.m. Zierke seconded the motion.
